of St. Lewis, at Quebec, this twenty-fifth day of October,  
one thousand seven hundred and eighty-four, and in the  
twenty-fifth year of the reign of Our Sovereign Lord  
George the Third by the Grace of God of Great Britain,  
France and Ireland, King, Defender of the Faith and so  
forth.
